Remaining City CIP Street Projects Moving Forward On Schedule

MCALESTER, Okla. – The final three City of McAlester CIP street projects are well on their way to completion.

Second Street from Comanche Avenue to Modoc Avenue (CIP #3) is expected to be fully open in December. The portion from Comanche Avenue to Seminole Avenue is already open.

The first portion of CIP #4 includes South Avenue from Strong Boulevard to Franklin Road. The Strong Boulevard and South Avenue intersection is open, and the entire area should reopen in November.

The final portion of CIP #4, Sixth Street from Wyandotte Avenue to Chadick Park, is expected to open in February.

CIP projects already completed include Seventeenth Street, “A” Street, and Sixth Street from Jefferson Avenue to Monroe Avenue. All CIP projects include new water and sewer infrastructure in the affected areas.

The funding for all CIP projects, approximately \$12 million, was generated by refinancing the City’s long-term debt at lower interest rates. When all CIP projects are complete, these funds will be fully exhausted.
